

ACRA AGM Thursday, October 3, 2019

On Thursday, October 3, 2019, our Annual General Meeting was held at Casa Grecque in Lasalle. Forty-four members were present for the meeting and the luncheon that followed.

As past president, Al Fitzgerald chaired the meeting. Al welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order. In the absence of Maria Di Perna, he read the detailed president's report that Maria had prepared.

- Maria spoke about the declining membership, the loss of Lali Jones, and the loss of family members and friends suffered by ACRA members. They will be remembered at ACRA's Memorial Mass to be held at St. Jean Brebeuf in Lasalle on November 10th at 11:00am.
- She reviewed the past year's activities, the reasons for certain cancellations, and the expectation that we would be back to a full range of activities this coming year.
- Maria spoke of the usefulness of the ACRA News and Muse to keep our membership informed on a regular basis.
- She highlighted the fact that our budget is healthy, and we are finishing the year, once again, with a surplus.
- She spoke of the registration process.
- She reported on the generous contributions to various charities on behalf of the ACRA membership. Because we have not been able to replace Jerry Dunn in organizing the Food Drive for St. Gabriel's, the proposed budget will earmark a \$1000 donation to St. Gabriel's to support their Christmas Baskets.
- Finally she thanked all members of the Board for their hard work and commitment with special attention going to Peter Yaworski and Al Fitzgerald who have completed their mandates and will be leaving the Board.

Our auditor, Richard Kusiak, presented his report for 2018-19. Our financial records are in order and he congratulated Tony Di Lallo, our Treasurer, for the excellent work he does in keeping all the financial matters in order. Tony Di Lallo then proceeded to present his report for 2018-19 and the proposed budget for 2019-2020. All three reports were unanimously approved.

As Past President, Al Fitzgerald presented the Nominating Committee's Report. A nominating committee was formed to recommend members for two vacant positions on the board. Raz Crivello and Bill Holowka accepted the nominations as new members and Joe Jaroslawski and Tony Di Lallo agreed to serve another two-year term. As no other nominations were received, by acclamation, these four members will be on the board for 2019-2020.

After the meeting, Frank Baldassare was invited to say grace. Frank asked those present to remember members and friends who have passed away. He led us in giving thanks for our individual blessings and as members of ACRA.

Another successful AGM and Luncheon was concluded.






ACRA Wednesday Golf
